



Prayer Card Directions

Students are invited to make prayer cards that will be distributed to people in Ukraine.

- Materials Needed: 3x5 index cards, sheets of 2x4 labels, sheets of Avery 5160 labels.
- Prayer cards are made with 3x5 index cards. You can use colored or white index cards.
- The text for each card uses the Cyrillic alphabet, which is very hard for students to copy. The templates can be printed on labels to make it easy for a student to peel and click on the card.
- Everything is written in Ukrainian and Russian. Look at the English translation document to see what each prayer says.

Prayer Card Directions

Front

Choose a prayer template to print 2 X 4 labels for each card. If you don't have labels, you can print the prayers on paper, cut them, and glue them onto the card. If you use multiple prayer templates, please sort the completed cards and rubber band-like cards together.

Back

Use one of the greeting templates to print Avery 5160 labels for each card. These are short phrases, so older students may enjoy writing the Ukrainian and Russian greetings by hand. Students may sign their first name.

Decoration

Use stickers, stamps, or simple drawings to decorate.
